- Fabric behind blocks: 3.5 m
- Cover strips between blocks: 2.75 m
- Border: 1.7m (joined)
*To make SASHING AND NINE-PATCHES from alternative fabrics:
- Dark: $12 / 3$ yards
- Light: 23/4 yards
**BACKING for QAYG (Quilt-As-You-Go)
Method:
- Fabric behind blocks: $37 / 8$ yards
- Cover strips between blocks: 3 yards
- Border: $11 / 8$ yards (joined)
