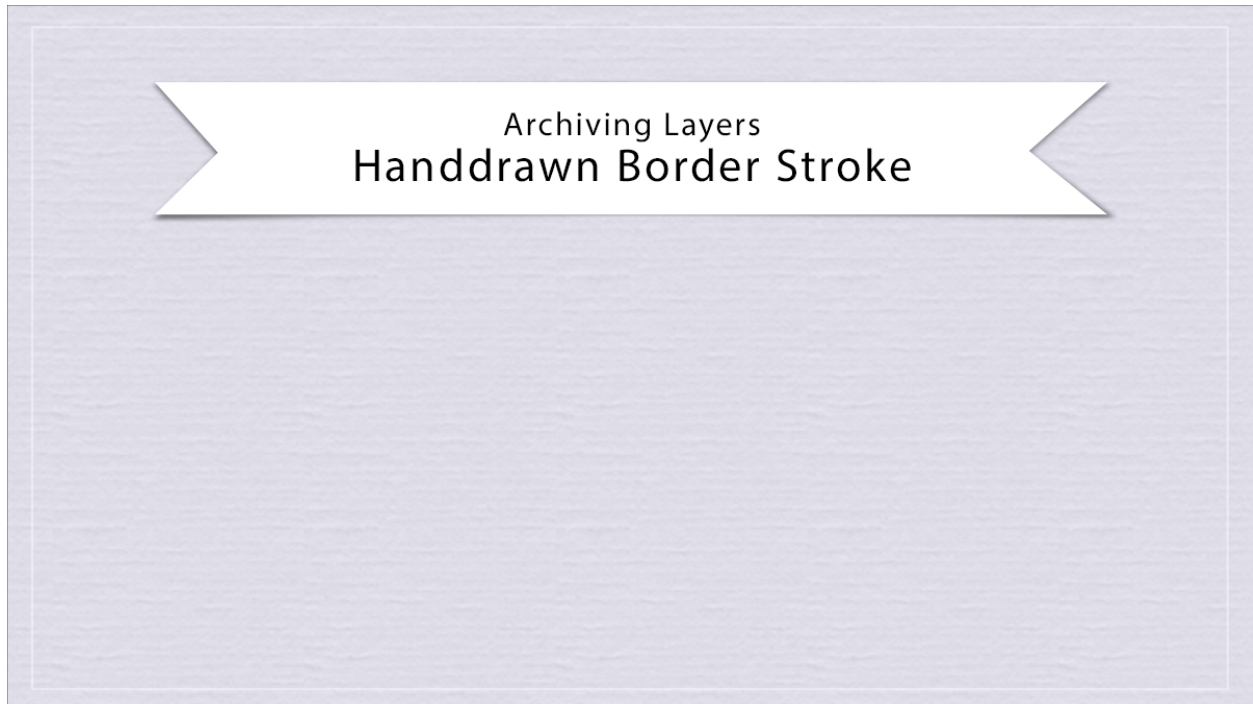

Photoshop Elements

- Open the document that you ended with in Lesson 2.
- In the Layers panel, Right click (Mac: Ctrl click) on the Hand-drawn Border Stroke group and choose Duplicate Group.
- In the dialog box set the Destination Document to New and click OK.
- In the Layers panel of the duplicate document, Right click (Mac: Ctrl click) on the group and choose Ungroup Layers.
- Save this document (File > Save As) as a layered PSD document with a unique name.

Adobe Photoshop

- Open the document that you ended with in Lesson 2.
- In the Layers panel, Right click (Mac: Ctrl click) on the Hand-drawn Border Stroke group and choose Duplicate Group.
- In the dialog box set the Destination Document to New and click OK.
- To revert back to a regular straight stroke, click on the Visibility icon of the Liquify Filter (Smart Filter) to disable it.

- To change the width of the stroke, double click on the thumbnail of the layer to open the smart object. In the Properties panel, change the width of the stroke and then save (File > Save) the smart document. The original document should change to reflect the change you made.
- Save this document (File > Save As) as a layered PSD document with a unique name.
