Start by playing over the progression without any tempo.


Then, add a metronome and build up to playing with the backing track as you become more comfortable with these chords.

Have fun as you expand your chord vocabulary and increase your confidence with these essential shapes and important chord progression.

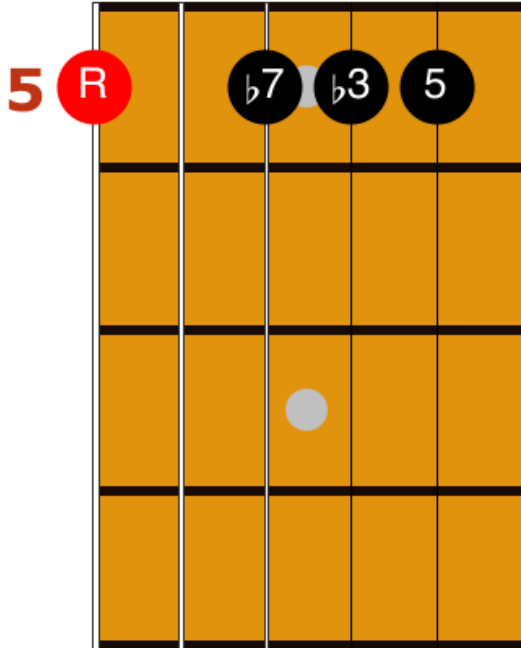
