# to have & to have got

► rovnaký význam  **mať, vlastniť**

**to have** → americká angličtina, viac formálne

**to have got** → britská angličtina, menej formálne

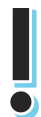
# TO HAVE

- ▶ plnovýznamové sloveso (tak ako iné slovesá, napr. eat, learn, drink, ...)
- ▶ použitie vo všetkých časoch



**Prítomný čas jednoduchý**  
(present simple)

I **have** a brother. / He **has** a sister.  
I **don't** have a brother. / He **doesn't** have a sister.  
**Do** you have a brother? / **Does** he have a sister?



**Prítomný čas priebehový**  
(present simple continuous)

I **am having** a shower now.  
**Are** they **having** breakfast?

Iba, ak hovoríme o aktivite!  
Nie vo význame mať, vlastniť!

~~I **am having** a brother.~~

# TO HAVE



**Minulý čas  
jednoduchý**  
(past simple)

I **had** a blue car. / He **had** a green car.  
I **didn't** have a blue car. / He **didn't** have a green car.  
**Did** you have a blue car? / **Did** he have a green car?

- aktivita
- frázy

breakfast	a bath	a good time
lunch	a shower	fun
dinner	a break	trouble

greetings from holiday: We are having a good time!

# TO HAVE GOT

- ▶ použitie IBA v prítomnom čase
- ▶ nepoužívame na vyjadrenie aktivít, iba vo význame mať, vlastniť

**zmena!**

I **have got** a new T-shirt. / He **has got** a girlfriend.

I **haven't got** a new T-shirt. / He **hasn't got** a girlfriend.

**Have** you **got** a new T-shirt? / **Has** he **got** a girlfriend?

~~I haven't / He hasn't~~

# Porovnanie **to have** & **to have got**

## **to have**

- ▶ I **have** two kids.
- ▶ She **has** two kids.
  
- ▶ I **don't have** kids.
- ▶ She **doesn't have** kids.
  
- ▶ **Do** you **have** kids?
- ▶ **Does** she **have** kids?

## **to have got**

- ▶ I **have got** two kids.
- ▶ She **has got** two kids.
  
- ▶ I **haven't got** kids.
- ▶ She **hasn't got** kids.
  
- ▶ **Have** you **got** kids?
- ▶ **Has** she **got** kids?
