A lot of adjectives which end in -ble in English, are the same in Italian, just ending with -bile, see 5 of them below:

Impossibile - impossible (pronounced: impossibile)

Possibile - possible (pronounced: possibile)

Incredibile - incredible (pronounced: incredibile)

Probabile - probable (pronounced: probabile)

Responsabile - responsible (pronounced: responsabile)

Medico - medical (pronounced: mediko)

Economia - economy (pronounced: economia)

Economico - economical, economic (pronounced: economico)

Futuro - future (pronounced: futuro)

Causa - a cause (pronounced: kauza)

Banca - a bank (pronounced: banka)

Parco - a park (pronounced: parko)
