

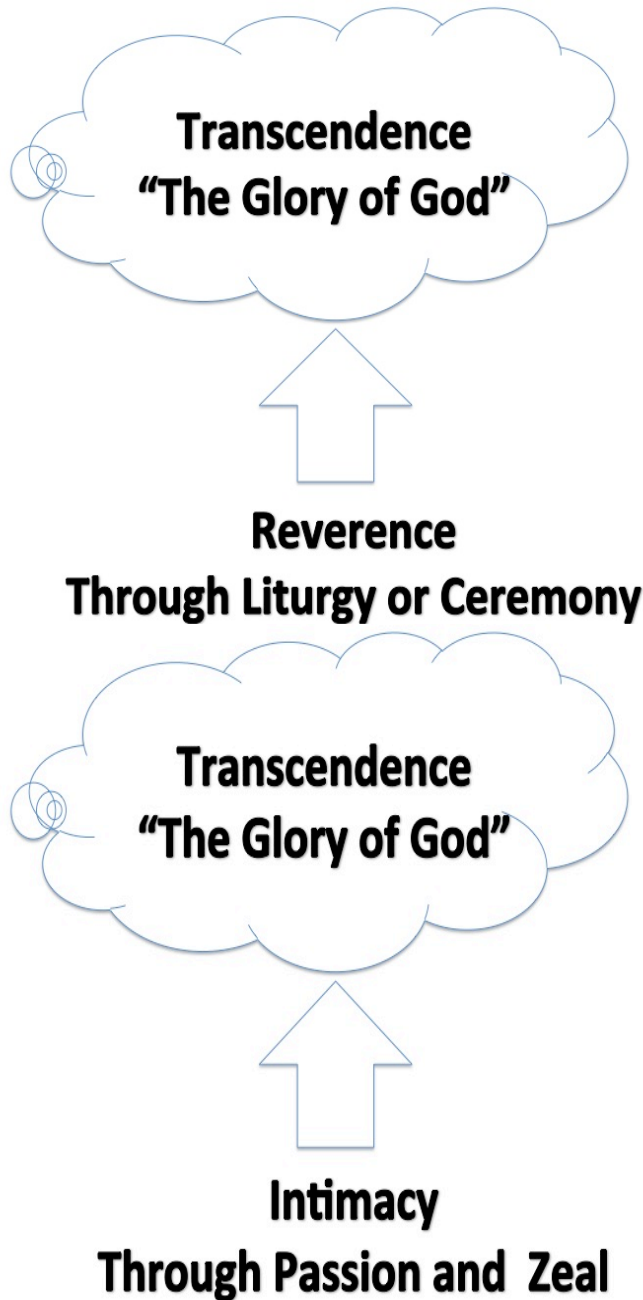

Shekinah is derived from the Hebrew verb שכן. The **word** means literally *to settle, inhabit, or dwell*. The root word is often used to refer to birds' nesting and nests. The word for Tabernacle, *mishkan*, is a derivative of the same root and is used in the sense of dwelling-place in the Bible
