



Baby Zebra Main Activity



This week we are Looking at how playing on the floor stimulates your baby's senses, especially their sense of touch, and helps them to develop body awareness. Our animal this week is the zebra.

You will need:

Printed PDF of zebra face

Toilet roll inner

White paper

Black paint

Paint brush/sponge

Scissors

Glue Rolled up towel to place underneath chest

Soft carpet or playmat



Method:

1. Measure and cut the white paper so that it will fit around the toilet roll inner
 2. Using the black paint and paintbrush/sponge, paint stripes onto your white paper
 3. Once it is dry, glue the stripy paper around the toilet roll inner
 4. Cut out the zebra face from the PDF and glue it onto the top of the striped toilet roll inner
 5. Now put the zebra puppet a little bit away from your baby to encourage them to move to get it.
- You can make it easier or more difficult depending on your baby's age and abilities- see video for more details
