

Here is a small list of a few products that I have used in Europe and which have given positive results against thrush.

Please Read!

*** Please remember that not all products are available in every country, some have different licensing agreements and permissions. Also, only use those which are legal in your region/Country. You may also notice the application for the range of products will also be different from each other. Ensure thorough cleaning and drying of the hoof prior to any application for more effective results***

This is a Spray application (*product is by Cavalor and called Dry Feet*)

Warning: For external use only.

Applications:

- In case of a soft frog or sole, apply the product to the cleaned hoof twice a day, or use it preventively twice a week to keep frogs and soles healthy.

Additional information:

- The new Cavalor ® Dry Feet formula is 100% natural and contains a combination of good bacteria (probiotics) and inulin (prebiotics). Inulin promotes the activity of the probiotics in the product as well as the good microorganisms already present on the hoof. These colonise the entire surface of the hoof, actively displacing any bad bacteria that can cause issues such as thrush.

Can I use Cavalor Dry Feet on the hoof for any situation?

- It is not advised to apply Cavalor Dry Feet on dry soles. When the hooves become too dry, they may become hard, brittle and susceptible to cracks. It is important to keep the horse's hooves dry, but a moisture balance of the foot should be maintained.



This is applied with the applicator brush which is Included
(Hoof Solution is made by Kevin Bacons)

Directions:

- Brush out the sole, clefts, and frog meticulously (without using water_or dry thoroughly) and remove all dirt and necrotic tissue.
- Shake the bottle a few seconds before applying in order to resuspend the active ingredients in the solution.

Applications:

- Prevention: 1 application a week.
- Severely damaged frogs: 1 application a day for 3-5 days (depending on severity).
- **You may also apply *Hoof Solution* as often as needed.**



This is a Pour and squeeze application method (Thrush Buster)

Directions:

- For thrush, apply only once to all infected areas.
- For prevention of thrush, use once a week in wet environments and once every two weeks in dry environments.

Applications:

- One single application is usually sufficient for treatment and prevention of thrush.
- May be used on the sole and frog prior to shoeing with pads and silicone.
