In lesson ten we created a crafty stamped ticket. And in this video I'll show you how to add a custom shadow to that ticket using Adobe Photoshop. I'm beginning with the completed scrapbook page that we created in this class. And in the Layers panel, that crafty stamped ticket group is the active group. Twirl open that group, and in this case I have another group inside that contains a layer mask and a drop shadow. To start the custom shadow process, Right click in Windows, or Ctrl click on a Mac, on that effects icon and choose Create Layer. Then in the Layers panel, click on that drop shadow layer to activate it.

Next, I'm going to zoom into the ticket on my scrapbook page by holding down the letter Z and clicking directly on the ticket several times to zoom in. Now with the Drop Shadow layer as the active layer. Press Ctrl T, Cmd T on a Mac, to get the Transform Options. Then holding down the Ctrl key in Windows, or the Cmd key on Mac, click and drag on the bottom bounding box handle to skew the shadow. Then click the checkmark to commit. And that's all there is to it. I'll close this group to tidy up the Layers panel and then say the scrapbook page. So that's how you add a custom shadow to the cracky stamped ticket that we created in lesson 10. This is Jen White with Digital Scrapbooking Mastery.
