

#### **Guidance For Learning These Words**

When you are at the beginner level in Spanish, you need to increase the amount of vocabulary you know. And not just that – but you need to focus on the words that are actually going to come up repeatedly.

Learning the Golden 100 is a great way to do this! The 100 most common Spanish words you see here are a great starting point to increase your vocabulary. Because they are so common, you are guaranteed to see them just about everywhere in the language.

Here is a quick 5-step guide for how to use these words in your Spanish practice:

- Think about situations where these words are especially useful.
- Look through the Golden 100 and test yourself on them that's why there are two columns!
- Write them down on a piece of paper, in a notebook or on some flashcards that you will carry around with you.
- Practice pronouncing the words out loud.
- Try to practise the Golden 100 daily. Even just 5 minutes can make a big difference!

These 100 words will be the foundations for all of your Spanish studies, so you're going to need to know them pretty well! You don't need to memorise these words... but seeing them here will help you notice them when you see them.

The same rules apply to these example sentences: you don't need to memorise them, but studying them frequently will help you better understand (and remember) the Golden 100.


