Pumpkins Lesson

Learning Objectives:

Students will be introduced to the fall season and why we see pumpkins during this time of the year.

Materials & Preparation:

- Pumpkins power point (included)
- Pumpkins Match (multiple levels included)
- Pumpkins Picture Writing prompt (included)
- Youtube: Where do Pumpkins come from?
- Pumpkin picture for tallying/bar graph activity (included)
- Bar graph & tally sheet (included)

Instruction:

- What season is it? What kind of things do you think of when the fall starts?
 What do you think of when you think of pumpkins?
- Pumpkins power point

Full Class Activity:

- Watch brief clip on where pumpkins come from. Students can see how they are grown. Discuss the video and let students start their work.
- Pumpkin tallying/bar graph activity

Independent Working Time:

- Pumpkin Match
- Writing picture prompt

Wrap up/Closing:

• Review pumpkins and their impact on the fall season.

Other Ideas for Activities:

 Carve pumpkins! I love doing this every year. Get a big pumpkin, have students take turns scooping out the seeds (so they can feel it). Vote on what kind of eyes, nose, smile, face you want for the pumpkin. Carve it. If you're lucky enough to have a stove in your classroom, make some pumpkins seeds!

 Some years we were lucky enough to take a field trip to a pumpkin patch (you can tie in many skills and make connections for why this is educational).
