

Repentance & Forgiveness List

Instructions:

- Fasting: It is **highly recommended that you are fasting while saying the below prayer.** According to **Matthew 17:19-21** it says “However, this kind does not go out except by prayer and fasting.”

Please consider that some prayer may require fasting in order to demolish and destroy the works of the enemy that have been systematically fashioned against your life, potentially for generations in your blood line.

The superior Blood of Jesus Christ is more powerful than any demonic operation against your life and as a child of God, you have full authority to apply the Blood of Jesus Christ to your life and cancel every evil assignment that has been holding you back in life.

You can ask Holy Spirit which kind of fast you should do, how long, and all related instructions.

1 John 1:7

But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin.

- When to pray: You can pray to God at anytime, day or night, He is always available and never slumbers (Psalm 121:4) and as an additional component of your prayer strategy that is HIGHLY powerful is to pray at 12am midnight or at 3am.
- Thanksgiving: Come before God and thank Him for everything that He has done for you and continues to do in your life.
- Repentance: Ask God to forgive you for committing the sins below or coming into agreement with the abomination against Him
- Forgiving other people: According to Matthew 18:21-35, God cannot forgive you unless you forgive others. No matter how horrible someone treated you, we must forgive them. Should it be that we choose not to forgive, the enemy has an open door to wreak havoc in your life.
- Break the Covenant: Ask God to break the covenant, curse, and altar regarding to the sin WITH THE BLOOD OF JESUS
- Separate from it: Tell God and the devil that you renounce, denounce, and divorce yourself from every covenant, curse, and altar relating to these sins and ask God to break the connection points with the BLOOD OF JESUS

- Cut all ties: Ask God to break all ungodly soul ties, body ties, and connection points to all ungodly covenants, curses, and altars
- Replace: Tell God and the devil that you are now in the new covenant with Jesus Christ according to John 3:17 , Romans 10:9, and Luke 22:20. Also ask God to restore the purposes and plans that He has declared over your life according to Romans 11:29, Jeremiah 29:11, Ezekiel 16: 6-, and Joel 2:25. (All Scriptures are written out below)

Prayer:

In the name of Jesus Christ, Lord I confess that I have committed the below and ask that You would forgive me and my ancestors and cleanse me with the BLOOD OF JESUS CHRIST from (continue to say the list below out loud):

God, I ask that you would pull up and destroy the following roots in my bloodline (continue to say the list below out loud):

God, I renounce, denounce, and divorce myself from every evil covenant, curse, and altar relating to: (continue to say the list below out loud):

God, may every evil covenant, curse, and altar be broken with the BLOOD OF JESUS CHRIST:

Please note that not all of these are explicit sins from the Bible (ex. Single motherhood has not been listed as a sin in the Bible but it may be a generational curse that needs to be broken). Feel free to add to this list on your own document and use it for your personal prayer time.

You may also feel like you do not need to pray the entire list, however, you may not be aware of the curses that were opened on your bloodline several hundred generations ago. You better believe that the enemy will use any and every opportunity to wreak havoc in your life thus it may be wise to renounce, denounce, and divorce the entire list above rather than chancing it.

Referenced Scriptures:

Say these out loud during your time of prayer.

1 John 1:9

If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Matthew 18:21-35

21 Then Peter came to Him and said, "Lord, how often shall my brother sin against me, and I forgive him? Up to seven times?"

22 Jesus said to him, "I do not say to you, up to seven times, but up to seventy times seven. 23 Therefore the kingdom of heaven is like a certain king who wanted to settle accounts with his servants. 24 And when he had begun to settle accounts, one was brought to him who owed him ten thousand talents. 25 But as he was not able to pay, his master commanded that he be sold, with his wife and children and all that he had, and that payment be made. 26 The servant therefore fell down before him, saying, 'Master, have patience with me, and I will pay you all.' 27 Then the master of that servant was moved with compassion, released him, and forgave him the debt.

28 "But that servant went out and found one of his fellow servants who owed him a hundred denarii; and he laid hands on him and took him by the throat, saying, 'Pay me what you owe!' 29 So his fellow servant fell down [a]at his feet and begged him, saying, 'Have patience with me, and I will pay you [b]all.' 30 And he would not, but went and threw him into prison till he should pay the debt. 31 So when his fellow servants saw what had been done, they were very grieved, and came and told their master all that had been done. 32 Then his master, after he had called him, said to him, 'You wicked servant! I forgave you all that debt because you begged me. 33 Should you not also have had compassion on your fellow servant, just as I had pity on you?' 34 And his master was angry, and delivered him to the torturers until he should pay all that was due to him.

35 "So My heavenly Father also will do to you if each of you, from his heart, does not forgive his brother his trespasses."
