some of the best new stuff

- * new start menu
- * universal apps
- * settings app
- * windows app store

hanging out with the new start menu

- * stretchable, flexible, resizable
- * tiles can be grouped and resized
- * you can disable the annoying tiles
- * lock, logout, reboot and sleep are all here
- * "all apps" is "all programs"

the universe of universal apps

- * apps are mini-programs that live in the store
- * Microsoft has several built-in apps (that you can't easily remove)

the settings app vs the control panel

- * the settings app is the new control panel
- *  +xp opens the panel

the store app

- * think of it like Microsoft's version of the iTunes store
- * almost 1 million free and paid apps in store

Bonus: removing built-in apps

- * elevated powershell prompt
- * type `get-appxpackage` to list all
- * use `get-appxpackage blak | remove-appxpackage`

the bottom line

- > the start menu is nimble
- > universal apps are the bridge between programs and apps
- > the settings app is the new control panel
- > the store app is your hub for new apps
