

Supplies for Cultivating Creativity course:

- **Strathmore 400 Series Premium Recycled 80 lb drawing paper pad 18" x 24"**

Gather the following items as you have them. If you have very limited supplies, get the items in **bold**:

- assorted graphite pencils, suggested:
 - **HB, B, 2B, 4B, 6B, 8B**
 - **H, 2H, 4H, 6H**
 - **china marker**
 - **Ebony pencil**
 - 6B or higher woodless pencil
- **white plastic eraser**
- **ruler**
- **scissors**
- **acrylic paints – a few favorite colors**
- **watercolor paints – a small travel tin**
- **brushes – flats and rounds in assorted sizes**
- **glue stick**
- **Mod Podge (matte finish) or any white glue or matte medium** or soft gel medium
- **gesso**
- glossy white acrylic paint
- suggested: soft gel medium
- bone folder (or large spoon)
- **colored pencils**
- **CrayPas oil pastels**
- crayons
- Portfolio water soluble oil pastels
- gel crayons
- markers of all kinds: children's **thick and thin markers**, brush markers, metallic, Posca paint pens, **gel pens**, Micron and Pitt pens
- **thread for binding**: waxed linen thread, embroidery floss, crochet or pearl cotton, thin ribbon, raffia, or thin strips of fabric
- **sharp embroidery needle** with eye large enough to accommodate your chosen thread
- **awl (or sharp nail)**
- clothes pins or binder clips
- thick telephone book or magazine
- cosmetic wedges

Basic supplies:

- Q-tips
- tissues
- paper towels
- wax or deli paper
- paper plate
- heavy duty plastic knife, spoon and fork
- old gift card
- jar for water
- small spray bottle for water
- found papers from old books, tissue paper, sewing patterns, note paper, wrapping paper, junk mail, decorative papers, magazines, etc.
