

## **My View**

Unless when I need them turned on, I keep my rulers off to avoid unnecessary distraction and to keep guides from being created by accident. To do that

- To avoid distraction, close all panels except the Layers panel. To do that, Right click (Mac: Ctrl click) on a panel tab and choose Close.
- In the Menu Bar, choose Window and place a checkmark next to Application Frame.
- In the Menu Bar, choose View and uncheck Rulers.
- Keep document docked.



# **Layers Panel Options**

- In the Layers panel, click on the flyout menu and choose Panel Options.
- In the dialog box, set the Thumbnail Size to Large and the Thumbnail Contents to Layer Bounds. Uncheck Use Default Masks on Fill Layers, Expand New Effects, and Add "copy" to Copied Layers and Groups. Click OK.

## Troubleshooting Wonky Tools

- In the Tool Options, click on the dropdown menu, click on the Settings, and choose Reset Tool.
- If that doesn't work, try restarting the program and/or restarting your computer.

## Move Tool

- Get the Move tool.
- In the Tool Options, uncheck Auto-Select and Show Bounding Box.
