

Move 10 Frames

Hold down **shift** to move
10 frames forward/backward




Skip to Keys

If an object is selected, then
move in-between it's key frames
else all key frames



Jump to Start/End

Hold down **command + shift**
and press , for the start or
. for the end of the timeline



Move Selected Keys

Hold down **option** and move
selected keys by 1 frame or
also hold down **shift** and
move by 10 frames



Scale Selected Keys

Select 2 or more key frames
and hold down **option** and drag
either end to re-size them



Reveal keys for selection

Only show the key frames of
the selected objects
