

- You can use Evernote




Idea lister builder

- Write down your ideas when they come to you
- Keep track of them
- At the end, make an evaluation
- The equation of the complete idea:
 Subject + problem/benefit + business model



Idea lister builder

- Each page is devoted to an idea
- Who is giving you money?
- What problem you're solving?
- What business model do you think you'll use?
- At the end of the page, answer the basic questions ranking, enthusiasm
