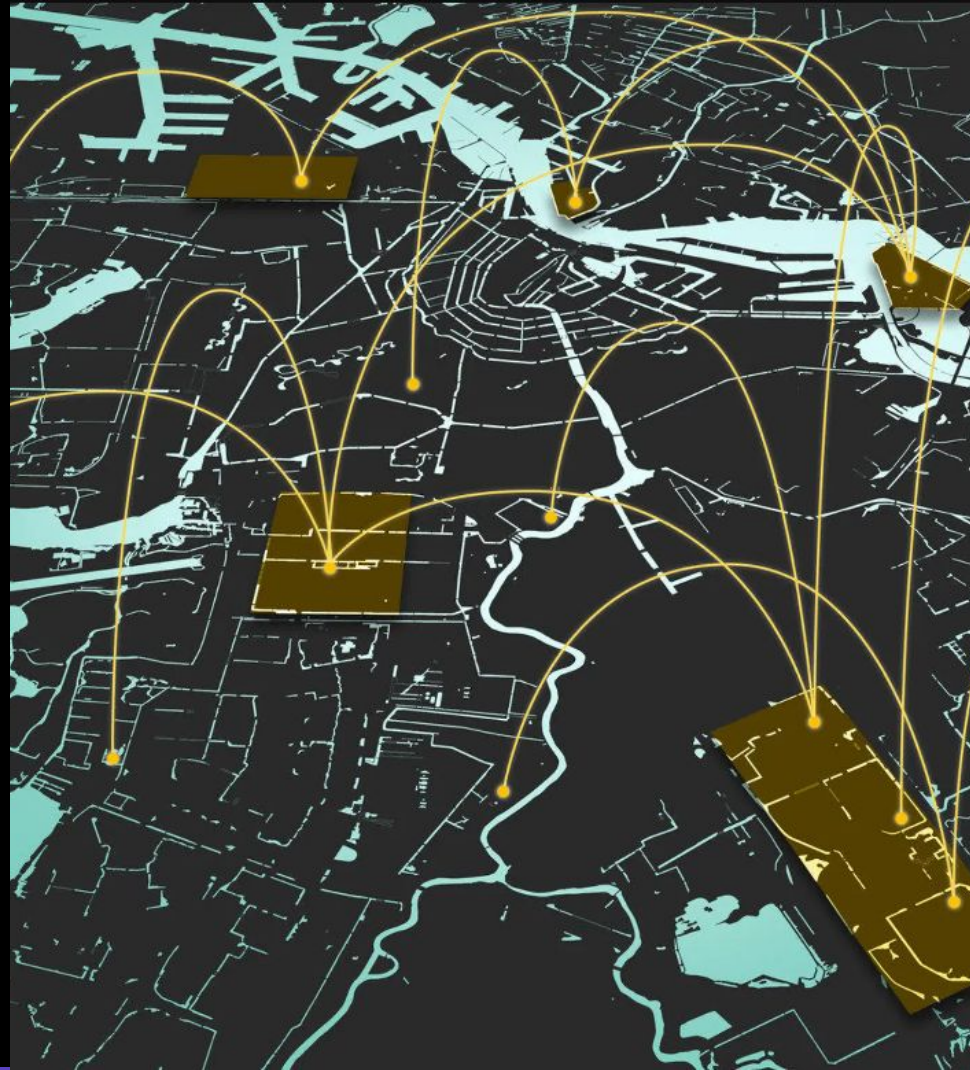
International Business Hubs

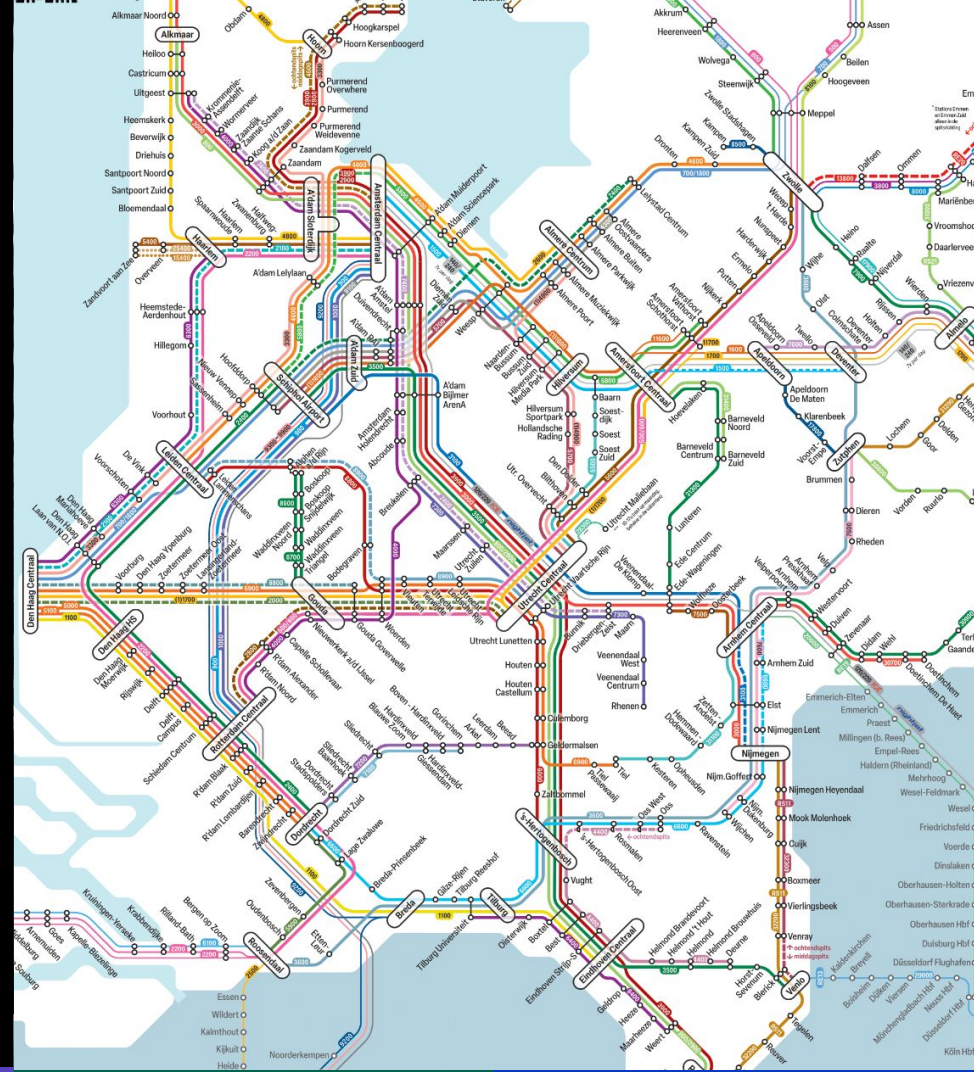

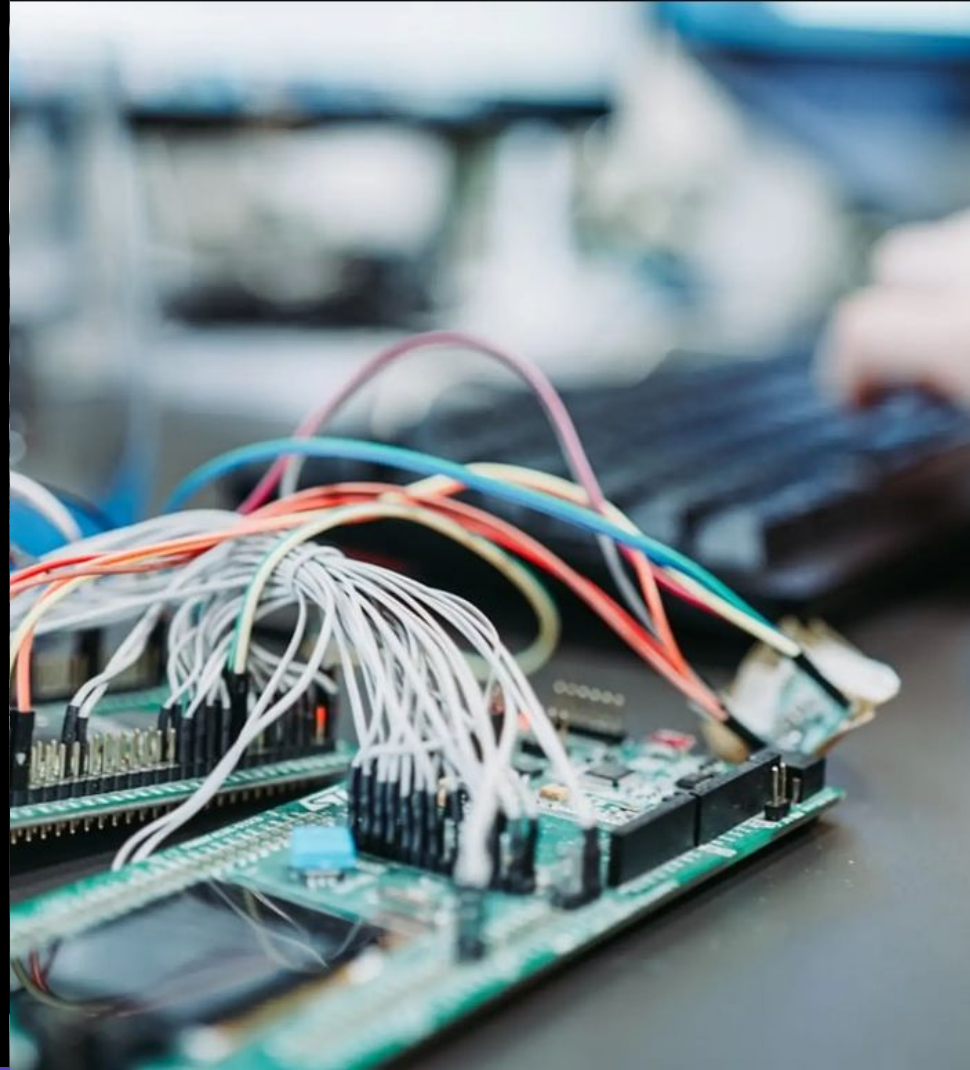
Quality of Life
