



# Glory School: Callings & Gifts 6 Week Syllabus

## **Week 1: The Callings of God in the New Testament**

- The general calling of all believers: Called to salvation, holiness, and service.
- The unique calling of individuals in the body.
- The calling of the church as a whole (Matthew 28:18-20, Acts 1:8).
- Summary: Understanding our calling gives clarity to our purpose in Christ.

## **Week 2: What We Are Called to Be**

- Called to be conformed to the image of Christ (Romans 8:29).
- Called to be ambassadors of reconciliation (2 Corinthians 5:18-20).
- Called to endure and remain faithful (Hebrews 10:36).
- Summary: Identity in Christ determines how we walk in our calling.

## **Week 3: The Gifts of God (Romans 12)**

- 1 Corinthians 12:4-6 as the foundation (Trinity's involvement in gifts).
- The grace gifts (motivational gifts) from God the Father.
- Teaching from Romans 12:6-8 on the seven gifts.
- Summary: God has wired us uniquely to serve in different capacities.

## **Week 4: The Ministry Gifts of Christ (Ephesians 4)**

- The fivefold ministry gifts: Apostles, prophets, evangelists, pastors, teachers.
- Their purpose in equipping and maturing the saints.
- The unity of the faith and the full stature of Christ.
- Summary: The ministry gifts are for equipping, not titles.

## **Week 5: The Gifts of the Holy Spirit (1 Corinthians 12)**

- The diversity of gifts but the same Spirit (1 Corinthians 12:4).
- Explanation of each of the nine gifts (revelation, power, and vocal gifts).
- How to function in the gifts and cultivate them.
- Summary: The Spirit distributes gifts for the edification of the church.

## **Week 6: Walking in Your Calling & Gifts**

- Stewarding your gifts and calling.
- Overcoming fear and hesitation in operating in gifts.
- Practical application: Identifying and activating gifts.
- Summary: The body of Christ functions best when every believer operates in their calling and gifts.
