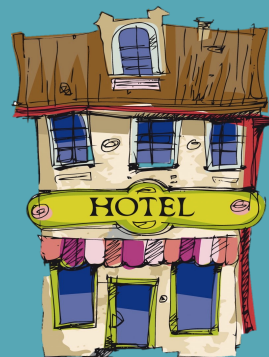

Taking the Tube Or a Bus



In London, you can buy an Oyster card.

You can use this Oyster card on any tube or bus.

You need to 'top up' the Oyster card with money to use it.



Buying a Bus Ticket



If you don't have an Oyster card, you can buy a ticket from the driver.

You: Hi, I'd like a single/return to Camden high street, please.

Driver: OK, that's £2.00.

You: Here you are.

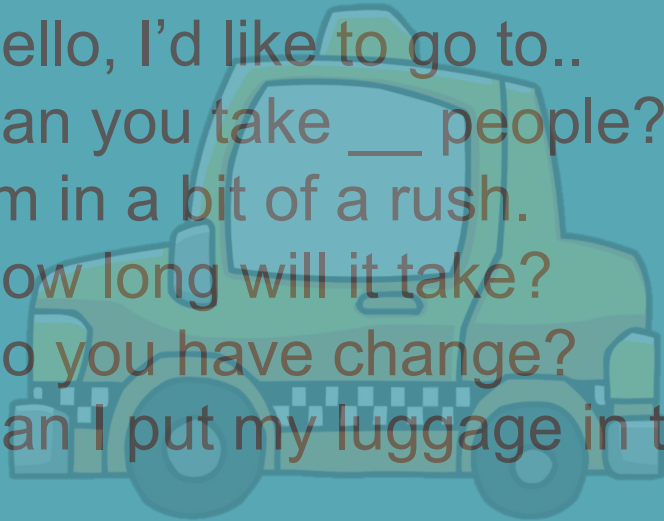


How The Driver Might Reply

You: Hello, I'd like to go to..

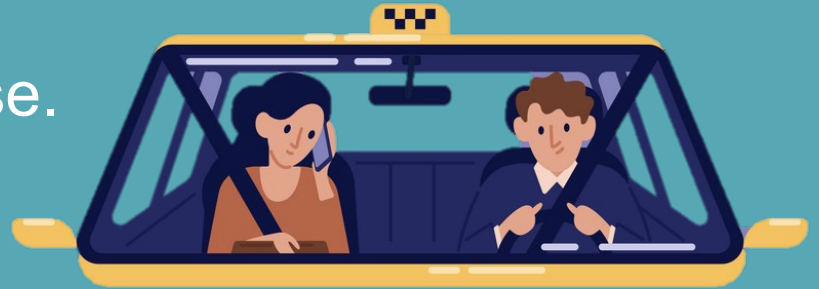
Driver: Sure, jump in.
